### REPRESENTATIVE PROJECTS:

#### 2061 North Campbell Chicago, IL

This building was getting a full remodel and refresh for its tenants. The multiple outcroppings and shape of the building implored us to use 6 variable length SSU platforms with 3 LNX 1000-pound motors.

Sky Climber teams also used a combination of our 45 Degree and 90 Degree fixed corners to allow close access to all faces of the building.

#### 1135 West Van Buren Chicago, IL

This new construction project required material hoisting access on the entire North face of the building. Sky Climber built a 60-foot long monorail system using our 8-foot aluminum beams connected with our full moment splice plates and joiner plates. Also provided our customer six feet of head room above the parapet wall. A combination of permanent anchors and counterweight systems were used to balance the beams.

**211 East Chicago  
Chicago, IL**

Sky Climber 1-meter porch assemblies allowed our customer access to all parts of the façade. With the increased load of the porch decks we used 2 LNX 1500 Hoist motors on each platform.

Our topside rigging utilized 32-foot beams with Sky Climber Rolling Roof Rig assemblies with 8 feet of outreach.

**100 Peachtree  
Atlanta, GA**

Sky Climber was part of the team to decommission the glowing static “Equitable” signs and swap them with large digital billboards. Our teams provided equipment and services to safely access this 453-foot-high work site. Sky Climber manufactured and installed 68 roof anchors on the building for equipment and operator tie-offs, and developed 10 trolleyed swing stages and material hoist systems to position large steel outriggers meant to affix new sign pieces.

**1000 Museum  
Miami, FL**

This ultra-luxury condominium tower was designed with a curvilinear exoskeleton that minimized the need for interior structural support while maximizing the look of this sculpture-like building. Massive columns of glass-fiber-reinforced concrete (GFRC) on the exterior of this curvy skyscraper created challenges for glass installation, caulking, painting, and stucco work. This Sky Climber access project was featured as the cover story of the March issue of Scaffold and Access Magazine.

Sky Climber provided a full suspended access system with roof rigging, material hoists and suspended access platforms.

- Platforms were outfitted with wall rollers to help navigate exoskeleton features and 3-Phase LNX hoists to better manage voltage throughout the tall drops.
- Careful measurements were made prior to each platform descent to ensure safe clearance of structural elements.
- We provided daily on-site cord management and regular training for all users to minimize risks presented by the lack of protruding balconies, high winds and tall drops.

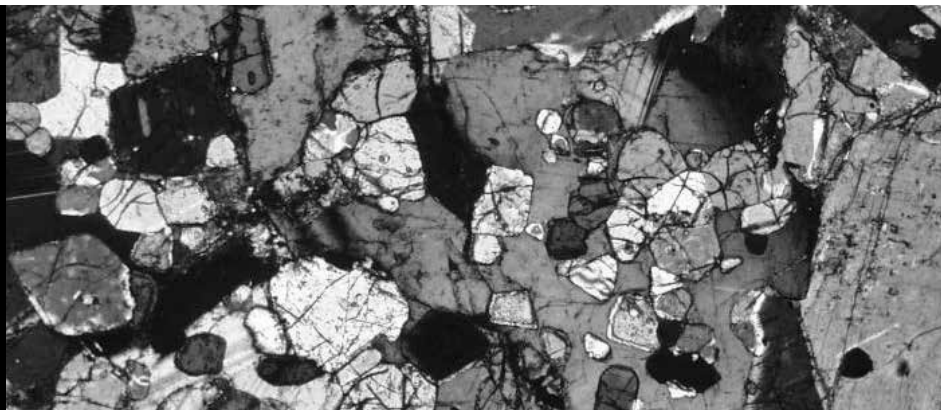

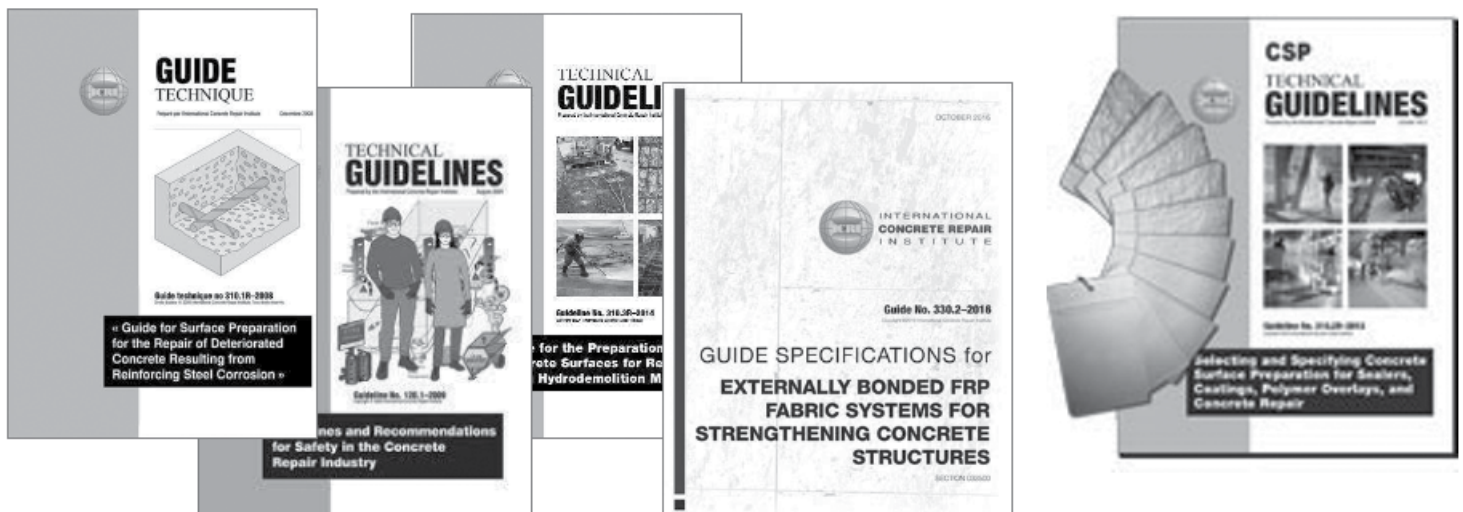
