

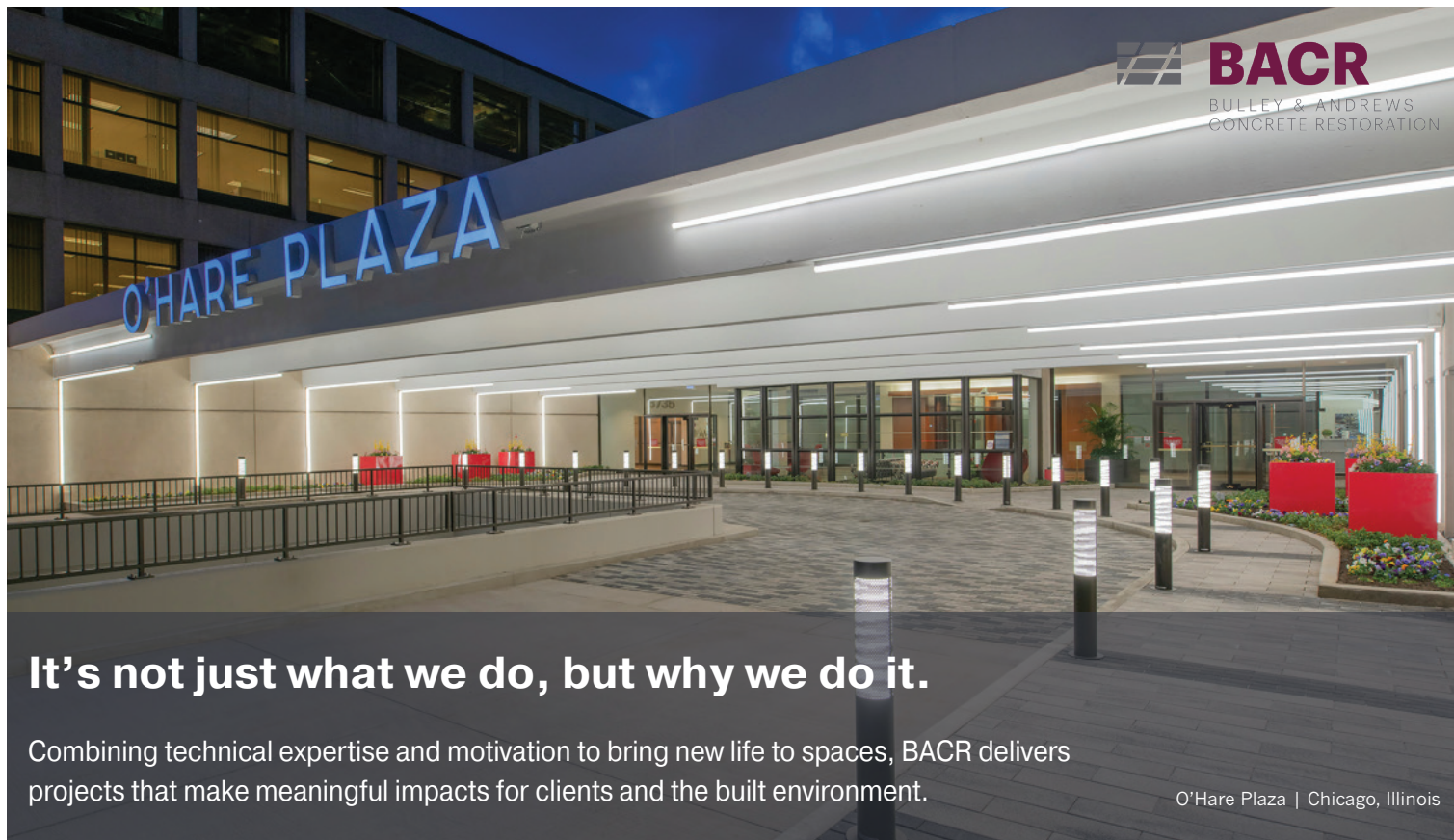

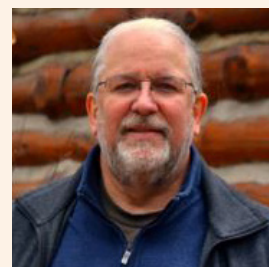

Aging twentieth century architecture is increasingly requiring extensive concrete repair, with a focus on repairs to prefabricated or poured-in-place concrete. ### CRITERIA AND ELIGIBILITY:

- Repair/restoration must be the major component of the overall project.
- The repair/restoration portion of the project must be performed, designed, or supplied by an ICRI Chicago Chapter member.
- Project submitted for consideration must be significantly completed by **October 31, 2022**. A single phase of a long-term project may be submitted provided it meets the above completion timeline.
- Maximum of one award per individual member or Member Company with multiple submittals.

### SUBMITTAL INFORMATION:

#### Part I (on a single page):

- Name of the Project
- Name of the Repair Contractor, Architect/Engineer, Material Supplier(s), General Contractor (if applicable)
- Owner/Owner Representative
- Must include a written permission from project Owner/Client to submit project for the award. This could be in the form of an email from the Owner/Client as an attachment to the single page.

#### Part II:

- The Name of the Project along with City and State where the Project is located.
- Overall repair/restoration project budget and duration.
- A written overview/summary of the repair/restoration project not exceeding 300 words.
- A written narrative/summary for each category of the aforementioned repair/restoration Project Scoring Criteria not exceeding 500 words per section OR 2,000 words total.
- No less than 6 photographs (8 ½" x 11" maximum size) showing before, during and after photos of repairs and scope of repairs. Individual photographs may be included under specific narrative sections AND/OR included as a comprehensive photo log.

**NOTE:** All submittal information cannot contain any Company or product information, Company logos or any other identifying information except for as required in Part I to ensure judges have no knowledge of Companies or products involved. Judges will not have access to the Part I information.

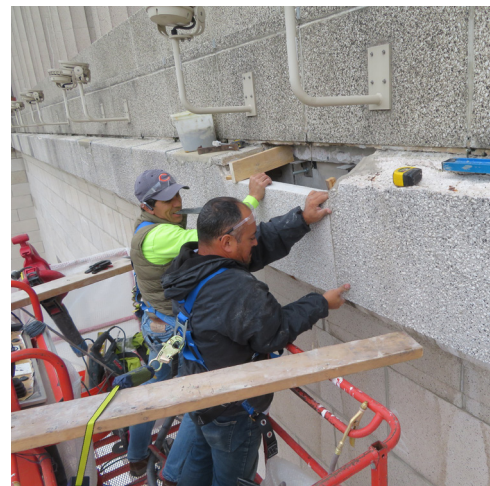

**SEPTEMBER CHICAGO CHAPTER DINNER MEETING**

On September 22, 2022 Chicago Chapter ICRI members and guests were treated two fascinating façade restoration projects in the Chicago area.

First up was Stephen Schmitt (WJE) and representatives of Bulley and Andrews Masonry Restoration as they presented the façade restoration project at the La Clare apartments, a high-rise continuum-of-care retirement community located in Chicago's Gold Coast neighborhood that was constructed between 2006 and 2009. The building is a 53-story cast-in-place, reinforced concrete structure that measures approximately 589 feet tall, has an eight-story podium with parking, a roof terrace at Level 9, and a residential tower that rises above the podium is curved in plan on the north and east elevations and stepped in plan on the south and west elevations. The facades consist primarily of coated cast-in-place concrete with architectural reveals and window wall infills, and there are several tiers of balconies with aluminum and glass railings. WJE and BAMR talked about the ongoing facade repair project, which includes concrete crack and spall, facade coating, balcony membrane, and miscellaneous window and balcony railing repairs.

The final presentation was made by Peter Nelson (WJE) and representatives of Bulley and Andrews Concrete Restoration team who provided some background on this historic stadium which Soldier Field was constructed in 1924 and is now nearly 100 years old. As many are aware, in 2003, the stadium underwent a major renovation, but portions of the 1920's vintage structure remained, including the original historic colonnades, concourses and the facade. But did you know that much of the original stadium facade is made up of precast concrete elements cast with an exposed aggregate finish? WJE and BACR are currently working together to perform an annual assessment and repair program of the historic facade. Ongoing facade repairs consist of replacement of full precast concrete ornamental/face pieces, localized precast concrete dutchman repairs and form-in-place concrete repairs. The joint WJE and BACR presentation discussed both engineering and construction related aspects of this project including: facade condition assessment, trial mix designs and mock-ups, casting precast elements with an exposed aggregate finish, challenges associated with the installation of large precast pieces as well as trial cleanings of historic concrete.

2022 ICRI CHICAGO GOLF OUTING AND LELAND “LEE” SIZEMORE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

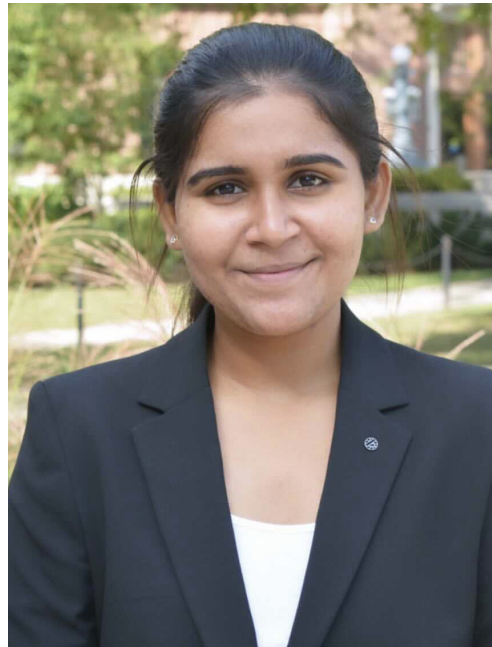

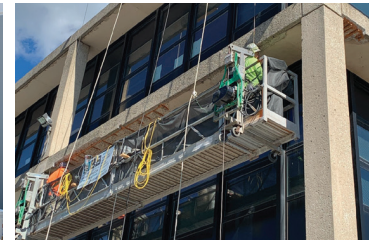
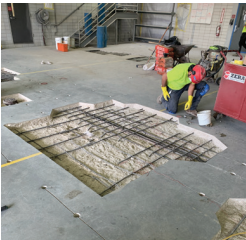
